

Auto Retro Barcelona 2011 presents its official poster

•*The 28th event will take place from 3 to 6 December at the trade fair centre in Barcelona (Montjuïc)*

Preparations for the international collection vehicle exhibition, Auto Retro Barcelona, are now underway with the presentation of its Official Poster designed by the Argentinian artist Juan Carlos Ferrigno, winner of the Motorin Art Competition (London 1996).

The poster, the fourth by Juan Carlos Ferrigno for Auto Retro Barcelona, is an original work in acrylic on canvas showing the Nissan-Datsun 240Z, winner of the East African Safari Rally in 1971, exactly 40 years ago, and driven by the Germans Edgar Herrmann/Hans Schuller.

The exact dates for the 28th Auto Retro Barcelona are Saturday 3 to Tuesday 6 December 2011, non-stop from 10am to 8pm. There will be over 30,000 m² of exhibition space available; the entire congress centre 2 and the Plaza Universo of the Montjuïc trade fair premises in Barcelona which, like last year, will be crammed full of products and activities.

The 27th event, held in 2010, incorporated five days of extraordinary activity and anticipation, during which sales and the tremendous number of visitors- an estimated total of 58,900 people – endorsed it as the event of reference in southern Europe.
